Re: Badminton Europe Coach Education – Tutors Course 2012

Dear Member Association,

As part of its development programme, Badminton Europe would like to have a structured Coach Education System in all Member Associations.

At the end of last year, BWF produced new resources for the Level 1 Coach Education system. Badminton Europe is organising a course for Member Associations to attend in order to become familiar with the resources. The objectives of such a course are:

- To have the Member Associations adopt the BWF Coach Education resources in their country
- To have the Member Associations' participants give similar courses to other tutors
- To have the Member Associations' participants conduct Level 1 Courses in the country

Each Member Association can register up to 2 persons to attend the course. If less than 8 Member Associations register, the course will be cancelled.

Prerequisites

Applicants:

- Must have already delivered coach education courses as tutors
- Must be, or prior to the course become, familiar with BWF Coach Education Level 1 resources

Member Associations who are not familiar with the BWF Coach Education resources should get in touch with BWF to receive all the resources and go through them before the start of the course.

Planning

The course will be on 15, 16, and 17 June 2012 in Antwerp, Belgium. Participants are expected to arrive on 14 June and to leave on 17 June in the afternoon (nearest airport is Brussels International). Ian Wright, BWF Development Manager, will give the course.

- 300 € travel grant
- 3 nights accommodation including breakfast
- 3 lunches (one on each course day)
- 2 dinners (on Friday and Saturday)
